Charging

- For maximum pleasure charge the toy before every use.
- Connect the included USB cable and insert the USB end into the wall adaptor or computer USB port (Computer must be turned on).
- The slow intermittent glow indicates charging in progress.
- A full charge takes up to 2 hours for 2 hours of play.
- Do not use the device while charging








USB charging port

Before Use

- Attach cups to one end of the tube.
- Connect the controller to the other end of the tube.

How To Use

- Press the cups onto your nipples
- Hold the  button to turn the pump on/off.
- Press the  button to cycle through 4 sucking speeds.
- Press the  button again to release pressure.
- Press the  button to cycle through 4 suction modes.
- Double press the  button again to release pressure.

Cleaning and Care

- Remove the motorized unit for thorough cleaning.
- Use a toy cleaner/mild soap with water to clean the product before and after each use.
- Pat with a towel and allow it to air-dry completely.
- Use with the water-based lube only, no silicone lubricants.



Warning

IF PAIN OR DISCOMFORT OCCURS, IMMEDIATELY RELEASE PRESSURE USING THE  BUTTON AND DISCONTINUE USE.

- Do not use pump system on inflamed and injured areas.
- Limit the use of the pump system to no longer than 15 minutes per use.
- Allow at least 60 minutes between uses, as more frequent use may increase the risk of injury.

Warning

- Do not use the pump system under the influence of alcohol or drugs, since it may impair the user's judgment and increase the risk of injury.
- Adult novelty only. Use for medical purposes or for a use that has an adverse effect on any function of the body is prohibited.

Precautions

- Incorrect use of this device may bruise or rupture the blood vessels within the nipples, resulting in petechiae (a small purplish spot on a body surface, such as the skin or mucous membrane, caused by a minute hemorrhage), hemorrhage (flow of blood from ruptured blood vessels), or the formation of a hematoma (localized swelling filled with blood resulting from a break in a blood vessel).
